The Peter Kiewit Institute is proud to announce the ninth annual **Academy of Excellence** program beginning at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday, June 24, and concluding at 2 p.m. on Friday, June 29.

This week-long program is designed to bring the brightest and most promising high school sophomores to Omaha for hands-on exploration of information science, technology and engineering disciplines. **Each student selected is required have their favorite math, science or computer teacher accompany them for the duration of the program in order to attend the Academy.**

Workshops will be scheduled, for the most part, in half-day increments and will be held at The Peter Kiewit Institute on UNO's South campus. During the workshops, students will have a chance to explore the many fields of study available through the College of Information Science & Technology and the College of Engineering, while extending their skills and interest in technology, robotics, engineering and electronics.

In addition, a variety of fun activities are planned for afternoons and evenings including visits to such places as the Lozier IMAX Theatre, the Henry Doorly Zoo and the SAC Museum. There will be an awards and recognition ceremony following the Friday luncheon before the conference concludes.

We are asking each high school to identify their top sophomore math and/or science student with interest in Information Science, Computer Science, Engineering and/or Technology. In turn, a selection committee will choose the student nominees for this exciting opportunity.

Invitations will be mailed by April 13, 2007.**

If possible, return the student nomination and teacher forms together – it is required that a teacher attend the entire week with their student.
